This Information Bulletin (IB) documents and clarifies the direction that was verbally communicated at the Providers' Operations Meeting of September 26, 2014.

Background:

With the implementation of the new CalJOBS system, several new fields were added to the Application Form.

One of these fields is for Alien Registration Expiration. This is a date field that is required to be filled in.

Between 1979 and 1989, The Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) issued Alien Registration cards (aka: Green Cards) that did not have expiration dates. These remain legal immigration status documents until they are mandated to be replaced by federal law.

If a person comes into the One Stop with an Alien Registration card with no expiration date, One Stop staff are to enter the following pseudo-date into the Alien Registration Expiration field:

01/01/2050
