- 1. Login to <u>https://plus.aztecsoftware.com</u>
- 2. To Create a User ID for the participant
 - a. Click Dashboard
 - b. Click Admin Center
 - c. On the Users tab Click + New to add a new user
 - d. Input the User Name as First. Last Name.
 - e. Input the first and last names. (Please note that the Username is created using the first and last names and is case sensitive).
 - f. Confirm the time zone is (GMT-08:00) Pacific Time (US & Canada)
 - g. **Password -** You may leave the password field blank and have the system generate one or you may create a password for the student.
 - h. Click force password change to require the password be changed upon first login.
 - i. Choose the TAG that represents your organization. If you are not sure ask your supervisor as this is how your organization's students will be grouped.
 - j. Choose Student from the Roles drop down selection.
 - k. Click Save
- 3. Enroll the Student
 - a. Click the Enrollments tab
 - b. Type your student's name in the Full Name field
 - c. Select your organization's Tag in the Tag filter
 - d. Click the check box to the left your student's name
 - e. Click Add/Drop Enrollments
 - i. Click on the drop-down arrow to select one or more of the following appropriate classes
 - 1. Pre-HSE Math FRWDB
 - 2. Pre-HSE Reading FRWDB
 - 3. Aztec's HiSET Prep Solution
 - 4. Aztec's Foundations Series
- 4. Change the Learning View
 - a. On the drop-down navigation menu, choose Class Center
 - b. Choose the class that was assigned to the new student
 - c. Click on Learning Views
 - d. Locate the student by name
 - e. Click on the blue gear icon and click on the "eye" icon to select Attach View
 - f. In the drop down choose **<u>No Post-Tests</u>** when the student is first starting a session.
 - g. When the student is ready to post-test, follow these instructions and choose Default as the view so they can access the post-test.
 - h. After the student completes the post-test, change the view back to No Post-Tests.

5. Student Usage

- a. The student uses the same URL to access Aztec's login screen. (remember the Username is case sensitive)
- b. The Student accesses their work under view classrooms.
- c. The student clicks Start on the tutorial class they are to use.
- d. The student must start at the first unit and work through each one.
- e. When the student is in the class they access the Learning Plan tab to walk through the lessons.
- f. Within each unit are a pretest, lessons, drills, and a post-test, which can be seen to the right of the lesson topic.
- g. After completing the pretest for each unit, recommendations are provided to give the student assistance in areas of need.
