**Subject: Individual Training Account- Maximum Amount and Duration
(Non- Sector and Sector Occupations)**

Applicable Program: Adult, Dislocated Worker, Older Youth

Revision History: Initial Release – 11/19/10

This Revision B updates guidance for determining demand occupations.

As authorized by the WIOA, at its November 18, 2010 Board Meeting, the Fresno Regional Workforce Development Board (FRWDB) has established the maximum amount of an ITA at \$7,500.00 for Non-Sector occupations, \$10,000.00 for Sector occupations, and \$5,000 for Truck/Bus Driver.

Identification of the sector categories are identified in the current Local Demand Occupation List, Non-Sector =1 and Sector = 2. The Local Demand Occupation List is accessed through the Workforce Connection website (www.workforce-connection.com). Click on "Training opportunities in demand occupations" (<https://www.it-frs.net/V2/pub/JobSeeker/DemandOccupationsJS.aspx>) on the Adult and Dislocated Worker Services page.

A training period may not exceed twelve months from date of enrollment into a training program.
