This Revision C updates timeline requirements that were extended by Department of Homeland Security, effective May 1, 2022 (for Form I-797) and October 31, 2022 for verification of employment eligibility documents.

This OD references OD 03-15, Fresno County Title I Eligibility Technical Assistance Guide; Form ELI-003, Section X, pages 50-51.

Due to announced delays by the Department of Homeland Security in providing Employment Authorization Document, Form I-776, an alternative form (Form I-797) may be presented.

The I-797 may be accepted under the following conditions:

- Must be issued between December 1, 2019 and April 30, 2022
 - Can only be accepted until October 31, 2022
- Case note the use of Form I-797 for Employment Authorization
- Must also present allowable documentation to establish identity, as described on pages 50-51.

By October 31, 2022, Eligibility staff must re-verify individuals who presented a Form I-797, need to present updated allowable documentation (will replace Form I-797). Eligibility staff is to case note the replacement Employment Authorization document.
