This Revision A provides guidance on the addition of Healthcare and Logistics as additional sectors and the expansion of training opportunities to all approved eligible training providers within the identified sectors.

The RERP grant seeks to identify quality jobs and build pathways to those jobs in close partnership with community colleges, employers, and other stakeholders. Service strategies will prepare individuals from disadvantaged communities to successfully enter and complete training and enter good quality jobs in the Construction, Manufacturing, Healthcare, or Logistics industries. Program graduates will complete any ETPL-listed training and participate in a Transitional Jobs or Work Experience activity.

CalJOBS Enrollment Requirements:

- WIOA Application
 - Select “yes” for NonWIOA Special Grant
 - Select “yes” for RERP – 2102
- Service Codes under RERP
 - All appropriate service codes

Fresno County Process Changes:

- WorkKeys Remediation – May be completed concurrently with training as needed
